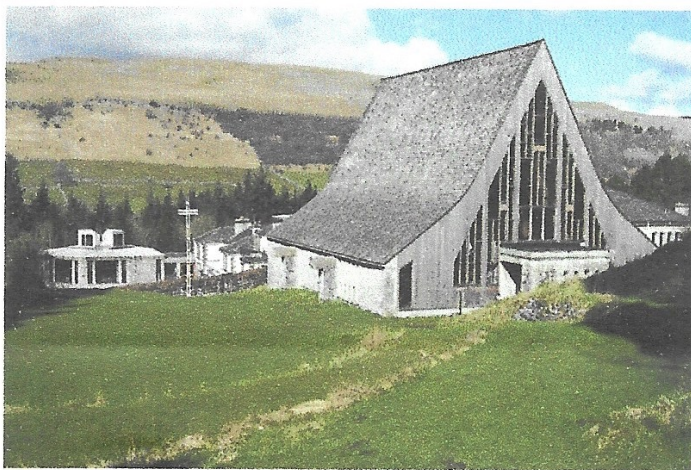


# THREADS OF GRACE
